Breakfast at Hotel

Visit **Akron Glass Works** and view the works of art at the area's only hot glass studio in downtown Akron's Northside arts district. Talk to the artists and browse the gallery for unique gift ideas. Tue-Fri 12-6 pm, Sat 6-11 pm. Glass blowing demonstrations Fridays and Saturdays.
